Over the last 2 years, we have seen robust, but to some extent time-limited, advances in telehealth policy. As the expiration of the federal public health emergency appears more likely and federal investments into broadband deployment begin in earnest, telehealth-related issues will be moving into a new phase. To stay ahead of these opportunities and to guide public policy, the NH Telehealth Alliance will host an in-person Public Policy Summit on November 15 from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM. We anticipate strong attendance from industry leaders, technology and healthcare providers, policymakers, other public leaders and regulatory agencies, to address emerging issues and engage in impactful discussion.

While the agenda is in development, we want to work with sponsors to identify and attract leading experts. The Summit will focus both telehealth developments and emerging issues around broadband expansion in NH.
